The information you provide will be used to determine the intensity of the earthquake, which is different from the magnitude. Intensity information provides important details on the effects of specific earthquakes and helps us to determine how your area may respond to future earthquakes. Please link to and fill out the **Earthquake Notification Form** listed above as fully as possible. If you believe you felt minor shaking you may have felt an earthquake and the information that you provide us will be very valuable in allowing us to provide statistical information in the form of maps and publications. Your name and Email address are optional but we encourage you to fill them out in case we need to clarify some of your information. The zip code and location or street information for your location during the earthquake are helpful for determining regional variations in intensity.
